

We are officially in the Fall Season. As we transition into this month, we recognize that October is Breast Cancer Awareness and Domestic Violence Awareness Month.

Breast Cancer is the second most common cancer among women in the United States. This month the Fundraising Committee has committed to spreading the word by gifting Breast Cancer Awareness hats with our logo for a suggested donation of at least \$20.00. I challenge each Zonta Mid-Maryland member to donate and get your hat as well as reach out to three people you know. We need the support of all our Zontians. A portion of our proceeds will be donated to Susan G. Komen Foundation and the rest will help support our Service projects. Domestic Violence Awareness Month (DVAM) evolved from the "Day of Unity" in October 1981 observed by the National Coalition Against Domestic Violence. The intent was to connect advocates across the nation who were working to end violence against women and their children. The Day of Unity soon became an entire week devoted to a range of varied and diverse activities conducted at the local, state, and national levels. During the month we mourn those who have died because of domestic violence, celebrate those who have survived, and connect with those who work to end violence. In October 1987, the first Domestic Violence Awareness Month was observed. That same year marks the initiation of the first national domestic violence toll-free hotline.

ZMM's efforts to support the Women Moving Forward (WMF) Conference through this fall's **Incarcerated Women Service Project was a labor of love.**

The first WMF Pre-Release Conference was held in partnership with the Maryland Correctional Institution for Women (MCIW) in the Fall of 2008 and continues to be held annually. The conference was initiated by the National Association of Women Judges (NAWJ), the nation's leading voice for women jurists dedicated to ensuring equal justice and access to the courts for women, minorities, and other historically disfavored groups. The goal of this annual conference is to provide approximately 150 women who are within 6 to 9 months of release with resources and information necessary to support their successful return to the community.

This year ZMM teamed up with MCIW and provided 100 "Goodie Bags" to Ms. Virginia Ngugi, MCIW volunteer coordinator. Thank you to the Zonta Club of Annapolis for providing additional gifts to include in the bags. Kudos to Zontians Alice Ross, Nicole Barnes, Denise Dobson McDonald, Erma Barron, and Carol Gardner for their hard work and dedication.
